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BIOREMEDIATION OF SEWAGE USING SPECIFIC CONSORTIUM OF MICROORGANISMS

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ABSTRACT

Municipal sewage problems are more complex as the volume of the wastewater is large and it requires huge area for treatment. The objective of this work is to evaluate a set of microbial consortium for domestic wastewater treatment. Lab scale bioreactors using specific consortium was applied for the domestic wastewater treatment.
